
NCCJ of CT & WMA Equity Leadership Alliance

On July 21, 2023, **NCCJ of CT & WMA** celebrated the inaugural commencement ceremony for the NCCJ Equity Leadership Alliance.


ELA is a 360° collaborative diversity, equity and inclusion (DEI) transformative learning experience for professionals leading whole systems reform in the workplace.

Congratulations to the 15 participating organizations and 30 ELA cohort members!


